It was upon leaving BPI Group, which operates in France, the USA, Spain and Russia, that Sabine joined Vigeo Eiris, after leading its turnaround.

Strongly principled and with an entrepreneurial spirit, Sabine has proven herself in numerous business transformation projects including those involving social dialogue, human resource development and business.

She also brings her experience as a corporate lawyer and has promoted the topics of gender equality and health through her successive professional roles. Early in her career, Sabine joined the Association of Corporate Lawyers (AFJE) of which she was President from 2001-2005. She was then Vice-President of the European Company Lawyers Association (ECLA) before founding two "Think-do-tanks" in 2009 and 2012: "Le Réseau Femmes Santé" (The Women's Health Network) and "Les Ateliers de la Convergence" (Convergence Workshops), which were born of the desire to reconcile business competitiveness, legal security and good recruitment practice. She has also been a member of the Conseil à l'Orientation pour l'Emploi - a permanent forum for debate between major players in the labour market (now known as France Stratégie) since June 2016.
